

Woodbridge Round the Town Charity Race 12 noon Sunday 18th May 2025

Dear Resident / Local business,

We will be holding the annual Woodbridge Round-the-Town Charity Races on Sunday 18th May 2025, starting at 12:00 and finishing at approximately 13:30.

What makes this race special is that it takes place in the heart of our great town and the 900 or so runners enjoy the fantastic atmosphere and support they get from spectators around the whole course. Each year we raise money for local charities, with over £150,000 raised by our races so far.

Road Closures

So that the runners are safe, we must close some roads temporarily.

Once again, we are asking for your patience and consideration, and we apologise for any inconvenience that this may cause you.

The map on this leaflet shows when and where the road closures and restrictions will be taking place

In summary:

- New Street and St Johns Hill, Burkitt Road, Theatre Street Angel Lane, Queens Head Lane closed 11:45 until 12:15
- The Thoroughfare, Church Street, Market Hill, Seckford Street closed 11:45 until 13:30.
- Drybridge Hill, Old Barrack Road to Seckford Hall Road closed 12:00 until 13:00.
- Old Barrack Road from the Deben Seal to Seckford Hall Road shared with runners.
- Ipswich Road, Station Road, Quayside and Lime Kiln Quay Road: Partly closed and shared with runners. It will be "One-way Only" left hand lane from the Red Lion to the roundabout at the Deben Seal open.

The period of most traffic disruption will be between 12 noon and 13:15, and we hope that motorists will be able to avoid driving in central Woodbridge or using Ipswich Rd/Station Rd between these times.

We hope you will be able to come out and encourage the runners – many will be pushing themselves to extremes for worthy causes!
